Key Scriptures

John 8:32 and you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

Romans 10:10 for with the heart a person believes, [a]resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

Hosea 2:10-13 "And then I will uncover her lewdness

In the sight of her lovers,

And no one will rescue her out of My hand.

11 "I will also put an end to all her gaiety,

Her feasts, her new moons, her sabbaths

And all her festal assemblies.

12 "I will destroy her vines and fig trees,

Of which she said, 'These are my wages

- Encourage people to not believe the crazy people.
