Key Scriptures

Jer 1:10 NASB "See, I have appointed you this day over the nations and over the kingdoms, To pluck up and to break down, To destroy and to overthrow, To build and to plant."

Rom 8:15-16 For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." (16) The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

The Big Point:

Our God has intentions for us to live a good and prosperous life. His instructions are to help us better understand Him and live according to our design. When we view life this way we can be the bridge between God and the world He is trying to reach.

Important points from the message:

- If our hearts are not right His instructions become a judgment.
- If our hearts are not right His blessings becomes a reward.
- If our hearts are not right His grace becomes a weapon.

Important quote:

- *"If our heart is not right we will use God's instruction as a judgment, we'll treat his blessings as a reward, and His grace as a weapon."*
- *"Christian history is a tradition of God revealing himself to person's heart, confirming the truth told through all the saints before us, and given in such a way to bear witness that Jesus is alive.."*
