Key Scriptures

Luk 24:49 NASB "And behold, I am sending forth the promise of My Father upon you; but you are to stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high."

Heb 4:16 Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Joh 1:14 And the Word became flesh, and dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Rom 8:19 NASB For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God.

The Big Point:

At certain times and places God transforms our surroundings into a temporary container for His presence and creates a sacred place of encounter. If we recognize these spaces we can enter into His presence and be transformed.

Important points from the message:

- God desires a connection.
- You enter into the sacred space by faith.
- The sacred space is waiting for you.

Important quote:

- *"When we detect the presence of God we encounter the sacred."*
- *Your marriage is just a marriage, your business is just a business unless you decide it is holy.*
- *Sunday service is the tithe of the week. When the first is holy the rest is holy.*

Questions that may get your group talking.

- Did you experience a sacred space on Sunday?
- Have you experienced God touching your emotions?
- How has God changed you in the sacred spaces?

Questions that may get your group thinking.

- What does the coat of many colors look like on you?
- What does it take for you to encounter a sacred space?
- How can you help explain the need for sacred spaces?
