Sacred Spaces



Key Scriptures

Heb 10:22-25 NASB let us draw near with a sincere heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. (23) Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful; (24) and let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, (25) not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near.

Heb 4:16 NASB Therefore let us draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

The Big Point:

When we don't remember where God brought us from, we lose track of how we got where we are and where God wants to bring us. It's so easy to think that where we are today is where we have always been, and we deserve what we have. Time and again Israel lost its testimony and in so doing lost its inheritance. When you lose your testimony, you forfeit your inheritance.

Important points from the message:

- Religion cancels.
- Jesus empowers your true voice.
- You come alive in the sacred spaces.
- Jesus loves your spirit, soul, and body.

Important quote:

- *We know we are reaching Christian maturity when we are more concerned with others than we are ourselves.*
- *By faith we create sacred places wherever we go.*
- *Sunday service is the tithe of the week. When the first is holy the rest is holy.*
- *There is a sacred space when you gather with other believers.*

Questions that may get your group talking.

- When have you experienced a sacred space?
- Have you been looking for sacred spaces?
- Have you kept your testimony alive?

Questions that may get your group thinking.

- How is your testimony connected to your inheritance?
- Have you found your authentic voice?
- How do you make the devil shut up?
