The Triumphal Entry

1When they had approached Jerusalem and had come to Bethphage, at the Mount of Olives, then Jesus sent two disciples,

2saying to them, "Go into the village opposite you, and immediately you will find a donkey tied *there* and a colt with her; untie them and bring them to Me.

3"If anyone says anything to you, you shall say, 'The Lord has need of them,' and immediately he will send them."

4This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet:

5"Say to the daughter of Zion,

'Behold your King is coming to you,

Gentle, and mounted on a donkey,

Even on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden."

6The disciples went and did just as Jesus had instructed them,

7and brought the donkey and the colt, and laid their coats on them; and

He sat on the coats.

8Most of the crowd spread their coats in the road, and others were cutting branches from the trees and spreading them in the road.

9The crowds going ahead of Him, and those who followed, were shouting,

"Hosanna to the Son of David;

Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord;

Hosanna in the highest!"

10When He had entered Jerusalem, all the city was stirred, saying, "Who is this?"

11And the crowds were saying, "This is the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth in Galilee."

Cleansing the Temple

12And Jesus entered the temple and drove out all those who were buying and selling in the temple, and overturned the tables of the money changers and the seats of those who were selling doves.

13And He *said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer'; but you are making it a robbers' den."

14And *the* blind and *the* lame came to Him in the temple, and He healed them.

The Triumphal Entry

Zechariah 9:9–10 (NASB95)

9Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!

Shout in triumph, O daughter of Jerusalem!

Behold, your king is coming to you;

He is just and endowed with salvation,

Humble, and mounted on a donkey,

Even on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

10I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim

And the horse from Jerusalem;

And the bow of war will be cut off.

And He will speak peace to the nations;

And His dominion will be from sea to sea,

And from the River to the ends of the earth.

1 Corinthians 15:57–58 (NASB95)

2 Corinthians 2:14 (NASB95)
