We need to come to the Bible each day. Read and pray over what we read. So we can be formed.

Pray in tongues. Seek God.

We need to view God though the season we are in.

Maybe its time to dust off old prophetic words you received and reinterpret what they mean based off what you know now and the season you are in.

Interpretation and application is the greatest challenge with prophetic ministry. You got a word in one season and interpreted it based on that season.

You may have moved onto a whole new season in life and you still hold the prior interpretation.

We have this expectation based on what we believe about God and it colors how we hear what God is saying.

In this new season you have a whole new world view. But you have this word in your heart that no longer fits into this season. You are left with either believing the word was wrong, someone blew it, or its time has passed.

You start to despise prophecy because of the disappointment of the word not coming to pass. Or, you would not want to enter the circumstance your interpretation was based on. The problem here is that we have

Stephen saw what Jesus was talking about when he was murdered.

Through death is a new beginning.

Nobody comes to the father except through Jesus. You have to die to life without Him.

You are being built into something in God.

You were broken and bruised but god used that abuse to help someone.

You were broke, but god is using that season of poverty to make you generous.

You were lied to and hurt, but god is using that so that you will not allow injustice to happen in your presence.

God is building a place of belonging in you!

God is building a place of belonging.

You broken people. Failed at life. Struggles. He is going to use them to be the cornerstone of something great.

In John they thought that they were finally going to get mansions. Finally going to rule and conquer.

Jesus said I am creating a place of belonging.

Acts 7:55–60 (NASB95)

55But being full of the Holy Spirit, he gazed intently into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God;
