Trusting Faith is expressed by being faithful to God and His ways.

Faithfulness is a heart condition where a person decides that following Jesus is the beginning of their ethics.

### Matthew 6:24 (NASB95)

**24**"No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.

- Internal faithfulness is where I can trust God to move in my life
- External faithfulness is where I trust God to move through my life.

### Luke 18:1-8

**1**Now He was telling them a parable to show that at all times they ought to pray and not to lose heart,

2saying, "In a certain city there was a judge who did not fear God and did not respect man.

3"There was a widow in that city, and she kept coming to him, saying, 'Give me legal protection from my opponent.'

4"For a while he was unwilling; but afterward he said to himself, 'Even though I do not fear God nor respect man,

## Mark 16:17-18 (NASB95)

18they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly *poison*, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

### John 20:21-23 (NASB95)

21So Jesus said to them again, "Peace *be* with you; as the Father has sent Me, I also send you."

22And when He had said this, He breathed on them and \*said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

23"If you forgive the sins of any, *their sins* have been forgiven them; if you retain the *sins* of any, they have been retained."

### Matthew 10:8 (NASB95)

8"Heal *the* sick, raise *the* dead, cleanse *the* lepers, cast out demons. Freely you received, freely give.

- Oppression is of the devil. We are supposed to do something about it.
- If God's got you, God's got this.
